Teresa López-Fernández is a clinical investigator and senior consultant cardiologist at La Paz University Hospital in Madrid, Spain. Her clinical and research interests are in the field of cardio-oncology (she is board certified by the International Cardio-Oncology Society) and cardiac imaging.

Teresa coordinates the cardio-oncology clinic at La Paz University Hospital. She is the founder and chair of the Spanish Cardio-Oncology Working Group at the Spanish Society of Cardiology (SEC). She is the current Vicepresident of the International Cardio-Oncology Society (ICOS) and the secretary of the ESC Council of Cardio-Oncology. Teresa has authored over 100 peer-reviewed publications and book chapters and is regularly invited to speak about cardio-oncology at both national and international conferences.
